Services provided by your company, EGA ASSOCIATES LLC, under contract # 36C24119F0232 has been identified as not only essential but also a critical service within the Health Care Operations of the Department of Veteran Affairs. As you are probably aware, currently due to the global pandemic COVID-19 several cities and counties within the State of Massachusetts have declared a state of emergency and instituted several measures to control the spread of the pandemic within the State.
